# COMMON APP

- Some colleges require the Common Application
  - Purdue and University of Cincinnati are examples.
- Be sure to confirm that SAT and ACT scores were sent from the testing center for IU, Purdue, UC, Miami University, NKU, NCAA and NAIA.
- As a part of the Common App, students electronically invite their counselor and teachers to complete the recommendation section. If names or emails are misspelled, the recommenders will not receive the invitation to complete this required section. If a recommendation is not completed in a timely manner, students should report to their counselor for support.

# PARCHMENT.COM

- Parchment.com allows ECHS students to send transcripts electronically to colleges.
- This is a FREE service from the Indiana Department of Education until the August after graduation.
- Parchment allows students to track their transcript and view it online at any time.
- NCAA and NAIA also require transcripts to be sent electronically through Parchment.

## Step by Step Procedure For NCAA and NAIA

If you are ready to register with the NCAA and NAIA, here are the steps you need to complete in order to work towards getting cleared.

- At the beginning or middle of your junior year, create your account with the NCAA at [eligibilitycenter.org](http://eligibilitycenter.org) or NAIA at <https://www.ncsasports.org/naia-eligibility-center> and complete the initial questions.
- At the end of your junior year have your high school send official transcripts by email or electronically through their connection with the NCAA / NAIA.
- Have your SAT or ACT test scores sent to the NCAA / NAIA by entering the correct code when taking the test or going to the testing agency website and having them sent once you get the results.
- After each semester of your senior year have your high school resend your transcripts to the NCAA / NAIA
- At the end of your senior year you need to have your final transcripts sent as soon as possible to avoid getting put behind the crush of student athletes registering.

Here are the things that need to be done by East Central High School in order to make sure you get cleared. If you do not complete these steps, you will not get cleared.

- Your high school counselor is responsible for getting your official transcripts sent to the NCAA / NAIA. This can happen by sending them through the [mail](#) or by sending them [electronically](#). You are not able to send transcripts on your own.
- The SAT or ACT testing agency will need to [send your test scores directly to the NCAA](#) / NAIA.
- You need to make sure you are being recruited by an NCAA DI, DII or NAIA school and they request your information be processed by adding you to an Institutional Request List (IRL). If you are not being recruited or your information is not requested by a university via an IRL you will never be cleared by the NCAA.

- Send ACT and SAT scores to colleges if required from testing center, otherwise they are sent with transcript. Retake tests if needed.
- Send ACT and SAT scores to NCAA and NAIA.
- Start Applications for college.
- Ask for letters of recommendation early to give teachers time to complete.
- Final Transcripts should be requested AFTER Graduation in June.
